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Welcome Spring!

Seasons change, and so do we. We are very proud to continue to provide high quality hospice palliative care to those who are dying and bereaved within our Barrie & area community. This year, in addition to our active residential, community & bereavement programs, we have also seen a marked increase in the number of referrals looking for complex bereavement support. Complex grief results when deaths are traumatic or unexpected. Our community has seen a significant increase in deaths by suicide, COVID-19 isolation and substance use causing death. We are constantly evolving to increase our capacity and support those in need. This year, we educated over 300 health care providers and volunteers by providing "Bereavement 101/102" sessions. As well, we have expanded our services to serve the Innisfil area by providing bereavement groups at Rizzardo Health Centre.

Hospice Simcoe Residential Update

Our 10-bed residence provides end-of-life care for those in our community who are living with a life-limiting illness.

- This year we provided care to 255 residents and the average length of stay for our residents was 11 days
- 73% of our residents had a cancer diagnosis and 27% of our residents had a non-cancer diagnosis
- Our team of Registered Nurses (RNs) and Registered Practical Nurses (RPNs) provided 17,865 hours of 24/7 care.
 Our team of Personal Support Workers (PSWs) provided 4,328 hours of care and Spiritual Care support provided 1,883 hours of support to residents and families
- 5 of our RNs received the Canadian Nurses' Association designation in Hospice Palliative Care (CHPCN)
- PSW students, from Georgian College, were mentored throughout the year by our clinical team for a total of 900 hours
- RNs and RPNs have participated in Learning Essential Approaches to Palliative Care (LEAP), Comprehensive Advanced Palliative Care Education (CAPCE) and D'Souza's Advanced Pain Assessment and Management Courses
- 7 Clinical team members attended the Hospice Palliative Care Ontario Conference

Community & Bereavement Support Update

It has been another busy year for our Community & Bereavement Programs. Our devoted team of social workers and volunteers have continued to support clients one-on-one and through group programming, while also expanding to meet the needs of our community.

Highlights of this past year include:

- Nearly 700 individuals supported, with over 3,000 visits documented
- Over 200 group sessions provided, reaching approximately 1,200 individuals
- 35 volunteers donated over 1,500 hours to Community Programs
- 25 volunteers donated 1,300 hours to Bereavement Programs
- 6 active volunteers supported over 30 bereaved children

Innovative programming:

- Program expansion to Innisfil including the first ever Dying Matters event held in Sandy Cove and the first bereavement group held at the Rizzardo Health Centre
- Bereavement education provided to over 300 health care workers and volunteers
- Community 'Death Cafe' events to grow awareness around Advance Care Planning, dying, bereavement and to destignatize conversations about death




